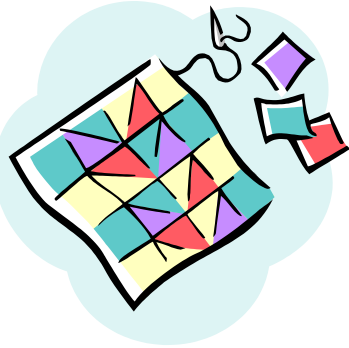

In 1990 the Kentucky Heritage Quilt Society sponsored “Quilters’ Day Out in Kentucky” on the third Saturday of March. The idea was for every quilter in Kentucky to be quilting on this date. Events were planned for every district in Kentucky, and quilters gathered together for an enjoyable day of learning and sharing their skills.

In 1992 the National Quilting Association established National Quilting Day as a day for quilters to come together in groups, large and small, to celebrate their love of quilt making. Since that time, this event has expanded to become International Quilting Day; and to think it all started in Kentucky!

HISTORY OF THE CLUB

In addition to monthly programs providing a variety of instructional and informative opportunities, club members have given their time to community service. Guild members worked to construct a quilted wall-hanging to aid Friends of the Scott County Public Library in raising funds for the children's department. Members routinely contribute small quilts and coverlets to the local Linus Project.
