

Recipe of the Month



Summer Squash Pizza

Topping

- 2 yellow summer squash, thinly sliced 1 cup thinly sliced onion
- 1 green pepper, thinly sliced

Preheat oven to 400 degrees F. Place

roasting pan. Sprinkle with rosemary,

salt, pepper and 2 tablespoons of olive

oil. Toss to coat. Bake in preheated oven

for 20 minutes, or until onions are lightly

brown and squash and peppers are tender.

Set aside. Increase oven temperature to

450 degrees F. In a medium mixing bowl, dissolve yeast and sugar in warm water.

Let yeast proof, about 10 minutes. Stir in 1/2 cup flour, salt and oil. Mix until smooth

then rest for 5 minutes. Add additional flour as needed to be able turn dough out

onto a lightly floured surface. Roll into a

sliced squash, onion and pepper in

fresh rosemary Salt and pepper to taste

2 teaspoons chopped

3 tablespoons olive oil 2 tablespoons grated Parmesan cheese

> flat 1/4 inch thick crust. Place crust onto a baking sheet. Bake 5 minutes to set crust. Remove from oven and distribute vegetable mixture on crust. Bake an additional 10 minutes or until crust is firm, being careful not to burn. Remove from oven, sprinkle with cheese and remaining tablespoon olive oil. Cut into quarters and

1/2 tablespoon rapid rise yeast

1/2-1 cup whole wheat flour

2 tablespoons olive oil

1 tablespoon sugar

1/2 cup warm water

1/2 teaspoon salt

Crust

Yield: 4 servings


