



Tomato Basil Bruschetta

- 3 plum tomatoes, chopped
- 1 3 cup thinly sliced and coarsely chopped onion
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 tablespoon red wine vinegar
- 6 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 tablespoon minced fresh basil or 1 teaspoon dried basil
- 1/2 teaspoon dried oregano
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 8 teaspoon ground pepper
- 1 pound loaf, whole wheat French bread, cut into 1/2 inch slices
