## Glazed Cantaloupe Bread

. nowdei

3 eggs 1 cup unsweetened applesauce 1 cup sugar

1 tablespoon vanilla extract 2 cups pureed cantaloupe (about one 5-inch round melon) 1½ cups whole wheat flour

Preheat oven to 325 degrees F. Lightly grease and flour two, 9 x 5-inch loaf pans. In a large mixing bowl **beat** together eggs, applesauce, sugar, vanilla and pureed

cantaloupe mixture; **mix** just until combined, then **pour** batter into prepared pans. **Bake** in the center of a preheated oven for 60 to 70 minutes, until a toothpick hiserted into center of loaf comes out clean and top of loaf springs back when pressed. Let loaves **cool** in pans for 10 minutes, run a knife around edge

plate it up

1½ cups all-purpose flour 1 teaspoon salt 1 teaspoon baking soda 34 teaspoon baking 2 teaspoons ground cinnamon

1/2 teaspoon ground ginger Glaze: 1/2 cup butter <sup>3/3</sup> cup brown sugar 1/2 cup chopped pecans

then turn out of pans to a cooling rack. For Glaze: Combine butter and brown sugar in a microwave safe bowl. Microwave on high a minutes, strining well at 1 minute intervals, until smooth and sugar is melted; add pecans to the glaze. Pour glaze over warm loaves. Allow glazed loaves to cool one hour before serving. cantaloupe. In a separate bowl, sift together flours, salt, baking soda, baking powder, cinnamon and ginger. Add flour mixture to cantaloupe mixture; mix just until combined,

serving. Yield: 20 slices Nutritional Analysis: 200 calories, 8 g fat, 3.5 g saturated fat, 45 mg cholesterol, 20 mg sodium, 3.2 g carbohydrate, 2 g fiber, 17 g sugars, 4 g protein.
