## Recipe of the Month



### Glazed Cantaloupe Bread

3 eggs	1½ cups all-purpose flour	½ teaspoon ground ginger
1 cup unsweetened applesauce	1 teaspoon salt	<b>Glaze:</b>
1 cup sugar	1 teaspoon baking soda	½ cup butter
1 tablespoon vanilla extract	¾ teaspoon baking powder	¾ cup brown sugar
2 cups pureed cantaloupe (about one 5-inch round melon)	2 teaspoons ground cinnamon	½ cup chopped pecans
1½ cups whole wheat flour		

**Preheat** oven to 325 degrees F. Lightly **grease** and **flour** two, 9 x 5-inch loaf pans. In a large mixing bowl **beat** together eggs, applesauce, sugar, vanilla and pureed cantaloupe. In a separate bowl, **sift** together flours, salt, baking soda, baking powder, cinnamon and ginger. **Add** flour mixture to cantaloupe mixture; **mix** just until combined, then **pour** batter into prepared pans. **Bake** in the center of a preheated oven for 60 to 70 minutes, until a toothpick inserted into center of loaf comes out clean and top of loaf springs back when pressed. Let loaves **cool** in pans for 10 minutes, run a knife around edge then **turn out** of pans to a cooling rack.

**For Glaze:** Combine butter and brown sugar in a microwave safe bowl. Microwave on high 3 minutes, stirring well at 1 minute intervals, until smooth and sugar is melted; add pecans to the glaze. Pour glaze over warm loaves. Allow glazed loaves to cool one hour before serving.

**Yield:** 20 slices  
**Nutritional Analysis:** 200 calories, 8 g fat, 3.5 g saturated fat, 45 mg cholesterol, 20 mg sodium, 32 g carbohydrate, 2 g fiber, 17 g sugars, 4 g protein.
