

Official Rules & Guidelines



4-H Council Presents:

Scott County Bale Trail *** \$20.00 Entry Fee Per Location***

1. No entry will be eligible without a formal written entry form

- 2. Displays **MUST** be visible from a city, county, or state roadway.
- 3. By submitting an entry form, you are granting permission to the Scott County 4-H Council to document, photograph, and promote your entry in print, radio, social media, and other promotions.
- 4. Displays should not limit vehicle visibility, or in any way cause an obstruction to traffic. The highway/road right-of-way must be observed and not infringed upon.
- 5. There will be 3 categories of display: Non-Traditional (painted bales, etc.) and Traditional Fall Decor (Non-painted bales and Fall decor) and Mini Bales (for business windows etc in keeping with city ordinances)- Scarecrow entries can be in any of the 3 categories.
- 6. Square, round, loaf, loose hay or straw are acceptable. Decoration materials are not limited in any way, shape, or, form. Let your imagination run wild!
- 7. There will be 3 overall categories: Traditional Fall Decor & Non-Traditional & Mini Bales
- 8. Return the entry form and fee to the Scott County Extension Office, 1130 Cincinnati Rd, Georgetown, KY 40324. For any questions call the office at 502-863-0984.
- 9. Bales must be decorated in a good clean wholesome nature in keeping with the values of the Scott County 4-H program. **NO** commercial, political, reference to drug or alcohol, or racial messages will be accepted or tolerated.
- 10. Displays **MUST** be up for display by **September 27, 2024.** Any bale not completed by this date will be disqualified from judging and not listed on the map for the public.

Entry forms will be accepted **September 1-23, 2024.** Entries not received by this date **IMPPORTANT DATES:** will not be eligible for awards and may be left off the map. Maps will be available on October 1, 2024. Entries MUST be completed and on display by September 27, 2024. Voting will take place throughout the month. Winners will be announced on October 29, 2024!
